I. INFORMATION

2. LEGAL REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE CONTRACT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These General Conditions are subject to the application of the Royal Legislative Decree (R.D.L) 1/2007, of 16 November, which approves the revised text of the General Law for the protection of Consumers and Users, of Law 7/1998, of 13 April, on General Contracting Conditions, and of the Civil Code.

These General Conditions, signed by the signing parties, will be incorporated into all contracts of International School San Patricio Toledo and which apply to all the programmes contained in the information sheets and are binding for the parties, together with the particular conditions agreed in the contract and those that may be established in each programme.

3. REGISTRATION, FEES AND PAYMENT

In order to enrol for the chosen programme, you must request the registration form from INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL SAN PATRICIO TOLEDO (hereinafter: ISSPT), fill it in and send it back to ISSPT, together with the corresponding reservation. There are some programs with different requirements or forms that must be added to the general conditions mentioned above for the participant to complete and sign. All enrollments require a deposit payment of €150 to confirm the booking. Once the registration form is completed, you will be sent an email with payment details explaining where and how to pay the deposit to confirm you booking, you have 10 days to finalise your booking. Upon receipt of your deposit, you will be issued an invoice for the remaining amount to be paid by May 27th 2022.

Any booking made after May 27th 2022 will require payment to be made in full.

The payment of the amounts referred to in the previous point should be made to the following account (always indicating the name and surname of the participant):

Failure to pay, both in time and form, will be considered as a waiver by the student to attend the course. Enrolments made less than 30 days before the start date of the Programme must pay the full amount of the chosen programme at the time of enrolment. Registrations are personal and non-transferable.

4. CANCELLATION, NO-SHOW AND/OR ABANDONMENT OF THE PROGRAMME BY THE CLIENT

In the event that the Client decides to cancel the contracted Programme, he/she must notify ISSPT in writing.

However, the client must pay ISSPT the amount corresponding to the damages caused, including all types of expenses incurred by ISSPT, up to the current date.

For information purposes, but not limited to: payments to third parties involved in the programme: schools, residency staff, monitors, teachers, among others. In order to inform the client of the amount of the deductions or charges to be made for cancellation, they will amount to:

- 15% of the price of the programme (half the price of the reservation paid), if the cancellation is made between 44 and 30 days before the start date of the course.
- 30% of the price of the programme (corresponding to the price of the full booking), if the cancellation occurs between 29 and 10 days before the course start date.
- 70% of the programme fee, if the cancellation is made within 9 days before the course start date.
- 100% in case of no-show at departure.

The administration fees indicated in paragraph two (2) of these general terms and conditions must be paid to ISSPT in all cases and will not be refunded under any circumstances, unless cancellation insurance is taken out. However, if the client withdraws from the contract within 7 days of its execution, ISSPT will refund the sums paid without deduction of costs. The client shall not be entitled to any refund if he/she, his/her parents or legal guardians voluntarily leave the Programme once it has started

5. COVID PEACE OF MIND POLICY

At ISSPT summer camps, we are committed to ensuring the safety and comfort of everyone, from our campers and staff to the communities and countries that host our camps. This summer, you can book an ISSPT summer camp with the assurance that we have worked with local authorities and implemented policies and procedures to ensure that our camps provide the safest environment for your child. As well as being assured that our camps meet strict government standards for safety and increased hygiene, we also offer you the security of being able to cancel your camp booking if COVID19 prevents you from travelling*.

With our COVID *peace of mind* policy you can book with confidence and we can all look forward to a safe and adventurous summer.

**We will transfer your registration to summer 2023 or offer a full refund of camp fees in these circumstances: Student is unable to travel to camp due to having contracted Covid19; Student is unable to travel to summer camp due to travel restrictions or quarantine caused by Covid19; Summer camp registrations do not reach the minimum number required. A positive test or quarantine test may be required.*

6. FORCE MAJEURE

“In the event that due to circumstances beyond the control of the International School San Patricio Toledo, including any urgent government instruction, or cause of force majeure (natural disaster, war, health emergency including the pandemic and any outbreak of a pandemic) arising after the signing of this Agreement, If it becomes necessary to establish additional hygiene, mobility restriction, health, sanitary or safety measures that may force the suspension of the activity, International School San Patricio Toledo will provide the option to transfer your registration to summer 2023 or offer a full refund of the camp fees in these circumstances”.

7. ALTERATIONS AND CHANGE IN CIRCUMSTANCES IN THE PROGRAMME

ISSPT undertakes to provide the clients with all the contracted services contained in the programme, with the stipulated conditions and characteristics. However, the following considerations must be taken into account

- a) In the event that, prior to the start of the Programme, ISSPT is obliged to significantly modify any essential part of the contract, including the price, it must immediately inform the client. The latter may choose to terminate the contract free of charge or to accept a modification of the contract. In the latter case, ISSPT shall specify the modifications made and their impact on the price of the Programme.
- b) The Client must communicate its decision as soon as possible and, in any case, within three days of notification of the modification of the Programme. In the event that the Client does not communicate its decision to ISSPT within three days, it will be understood that it chooses to terminate the Programme.
- c) In the event that ISSPT is forced to cancel any of its Programmes for reasons that are not attributable to the client, or in the event that the client chooses to terminate the contract pursuant to the provisions of paragraphs a), b), c) and d) above, ISSPT shall not be obliged to terminate the Programme for reasons that are not attributable to the client.
- d) ISSPT shall not be obliged to compensate the client when the programme is cancelled for reasons of force majeure.
- e) ISSPT shall not be obliged to compensate clients in the event that the cancellation of the programme is due to a failure to reach the minimum number of people required (10 participants) for the programme to be carried out. In such cases, it shall notify the client in writing that the minimum

number of participants has not been reached and that the programme has therefore been cancelled. In this case, the client will be entitled to a refund of all amounts paid for the programme.

8. COMPULSORY PRACTICES AND STANDARDS DURING THE COURSE OF THE PROGRAMME

The participant undertakes to respect and abide by the rules of discipline and behaviour of the course, both during their stay in the facilities where they receive classes, as well as outside of them. In particular, in relation to the centre's timetables, the obligation to attend classes, meals, the rules of coexistence and behaviour with teachers, classmates and staff hired by the ISSPT and the prohibition of consumption and possession of tobacco, alcohol and drugs.

Non-compliance by the participant will result in expulsion from the course, with the cost of the early return home being at the participant's own expense.

9. AUTHORISATION OF MEDICAL TREATMENT CONDITIONS

In the event that a minor is in a situation requiring medical treatment and/or is admitted to hospital and/or requires surgery and it has not been possible to locate his/her parents or guardians, the ISSPT is authorised to take whatever measures it deems appropriate for the health of the participant.

10. MEDICAL, PHARMACOLOGICAL AND/OR SURGICAL TREATMENT

The participant must inform the ISSPT if he/she is undergoing any medical and/or pharmacological treatment during the period covered by the chosen programme. It is understood that, at the time of starting the programme, the participant is in good physical and mental health to participate in the programme and that the medical information accompanying the programme dossier is true and complete. If this is not the case, the ISSPT disclaims any liability arising from the falsity of the information.

11. ELECTRONIC DEVICES

The ISSPT is not responsible for the loss and/or damage of electronic devices that the participant may bring to the chosen programme.

The ISSPT will make available contact telephone numbers with a fixed schedule for contacting participants. The ISSPT will provide the call schedule and telephone numbers prior to the start of the programme.

12. DOCUMENTATION

All participants booking ISSPT summer programmes are required to carry the necessary personal documentation (ID card, passport, health insurance card) in accordance with the laws of the country where the programme is being held.

ISSPT will not be held responsible for any liability or expense arising from non-compliance on the part of the participant, their parents or guardians.

13. INSURANCES

Accident and liability insurance

All participants in the ISSPT Summer Camps who are pupils of the school are covered by an accident insurance policy for any accidents that may occur during any of the activities organised by the school. The school has also taken out civil liability insurance to cover any contingency or damage to third parties during these activities.

The aforementioned accident insurance is not health insurance, so it is necessary for participants to carry their own health insurance card (social security or private entity) with them during the Summer Camps in case it is necessary to receive a medical service as a consequence of any incident related to the student's health not derived from an accident, but originated by another cause.

International students must also prove that they have taken out private medical insurance.

We also recommend that families take out dental insurance to complement the school's accident insurance, as cover for possible damages of this nature is limited as it is a group policy.

Participants in the Summer Camps who are not pupils of the school should inform the school of this circumstance so that they can be included in the accident insurance policy by taking out the corresponding supplement. The rest of the indications and recommendations expressed in this section are equally applicable to them.

14. PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA AND IMAGE PROCESSING

Data Controller: INSDE, SLU - International School San Patricio Toledo.

Purpose of processing:

- a) Presentation, management and invoicing of the camps.
- b) Responsible handling re. data of student in relation to the health data provided.
- c) Publication of images of the participants, taken during the activity and/or their names and surnames for informative or advertising purposes, provided that such sharing does not imply or could imply harm to their honour or reputation or that it is contrary to their interests or illegitimate intrusion into the privacy or reputation of the participant.
- d) Sending offers, promotions and newsletters of the centre through any multichannel media (email, SMS, post, etc).

Purposes c) and d) will take place as long as the applicant has ticked the corresponding box on the registration form.

Legitimation of the processing: Consent of the data subject and the present terms and conditions.

Communication of data: The data may be communicated to banks for the collection of receipts and to third parties involved in the organisation of the outings or excursions included in the camp.

Those suppliers who provide us with a service as data processors and with whom we have signed the corresponding contracts may have access to your data.

INSDE, S.L. makes use of Google Education whereby data may be stored, processed and

transmitted to the United States and locations around the world. Google has addenda adapted to the RGD regulations to be signed with its clients to regulate the relationship.

Retention of data: Registration data will be kept until the end of the camp, unless the participant has given their consent for the sending of communications or the publication of images, in which case they will be kept until they request to unsubscribe from communications or the deletion of the image. Invoicing data will be kept for the legally established periods.

Rights of the interested party: - The right to withdraw consent at any time. - Right of access, rectification, portability and deletion of their data and to limit or oppose its processing. - The right to lodge a complaint with the Spanish supervisory authority (www.aepd.es) if he/she considers that the processing does not comply with the regulations in force.

15. CONFLICT RESOLUTION

Any disputes relating to the programmes shall be settled by the competent courts in accordance with the applicable law.

16. VALIDITY

These general terms and conditions shall be valid from 1 December 2021 to 31 December 2022 inclusive.
